(2) Many emeralds and rubies are filled for clarity enhancement and can be damaged by ultrasonic waves. Use with caution or consult your jeweler before cleaning these gemstones with an ultrasonic cleaner.

(3) Ultrasonic machines can only clean silver jewelry, not remove tarnish. Use only with water or a non-ammoniated cleaner.

(4) Damaged jewelry should not be cleaned using an ultrasonic cleaner. Consult your professional jeweler if you have any questions on what can or cannot be cleaned using an ultrasonic cleaner.
